1 Installation

| Issue | Description | Release Notes |
|-------|-------------------|--|
| 3597 | Check for updates | <p>If a practice has 'skipped' the option to take updates available for CAT they will not be prompted again when new updates are released. This has caused problems for practices in the past.</p> <p>A new menu option has been added to allow practices to check for updates in case some have been missed: Tools > Check for Updates</p> <p>Note: the practice must have installed a minimum of CAT 2.8 for this option to be available.</p> |

| Issue | Description | Release Notes |
|-------|--|--|
| 2653 | Scheduled collections <i>Please note that the scheduler is not available for Genie users.</i> | <p>The PCS CAT Scheduled Collections is a separate application that is installed on one PC only at a practice and is configured to schedule collections at a convenient time (eg. overnight) and at regular intervals (eg. monthly). The scheduler needs to be installed with administrator privileges and may require the practice IT manager to be consulted.</p> <p>Divisions should contact PCS for further information about the scheduler installation.</p> |
| 3958 | Deidentify tool | <p>A data extract can be deidentified using the Deidentify tool. This is now available as a menu option within CAT: Tools > Deidentify Dataset</p> <p>You must load the data set you wish to deidentify before running the tool. The new deidentified dataset will appear in your list of extracts.</p> |

4 Filters

| Issue | Description | Release Notes |
|-------|---|---|
| 5884 | Visits in last 6 months bug | This filter will now work if you type in a numerical value rather than selecting it from the drop-down list. Note that you must type in a value that exists in the drop-down list or you will be alerted with an error. |
| 5962 | Dementia filter incorrectly available for older data sets | This bug is now fixed – the Dementia filter will grey-out when it is not available. |

5 Charts

| Issue | Description | Release Notes |
|-------|--|---|
| 3779 | Select All checkbox | A 'Select All' checkbox has been added to all charts allowing you to select all the segments on a chart by ticking the box. This is useful for practices making use of the cross-tabulation 'Report' button. |
| 3787 | Age bracket changes should not require a recalculate | Changing the age bracket range on the Demographics, BMI or CV Risk graph will now take immediate effect rather than requiring a recalculate. |
| 5683 | Diabetes Worksheet improvements | The Diabetes Worksheet will now report the value for an item that has been completed where it can, rather than simply indicating that an item has been completed. Completed items with no value (eg. smoking) are now indicated by a tick (✓) rather than a dot. |
| 5960 | Medications graph bug | The stimulants medication segment was incorrectly showing as antipsychotics in the filter text. This has been corrected. |
