These release notes are provided to give an overview of the issues that have been reported and fixed in this release of Clinical Audit. Where necessary explanatory notes are given about new or upgraded functionality.

This release of Clinical Audit is specifically to include the new NPI Reports for the reporting period 2008-09.

NPI Report Changes for 2008-09

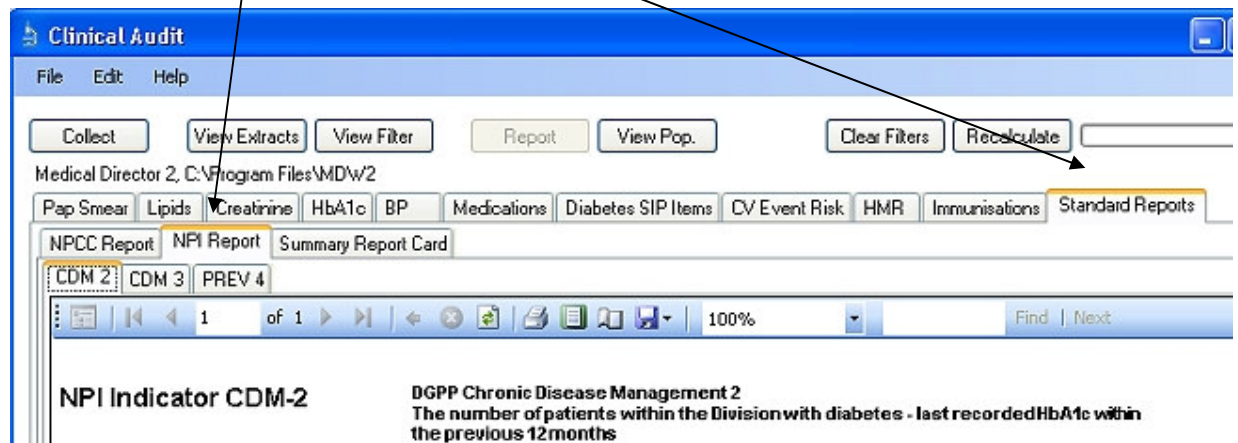
The NPI Reports for 30/06/2008 have been removed. These were:

- N_DIA 4.1 for reporting on Diabetes patients HbA1c results < 12mths
- N_DIA 4.2 for reporting on Diabetes patients cholesterol results < 12mths
- N_ASM 4.1 for reporting on Asthma patients smoking status

The NPI Reports for 2008-09 that have been added are:

- CDM 2 for reporting on Diabetes patients HbA1c results in last 12mths
- CDM 3 for reporting on CHD patients with BP < 130/80 in last 12 mths
- PREV 4 for reporting on female patients aged 20-69 with a pap smear in last 2 yrs




