

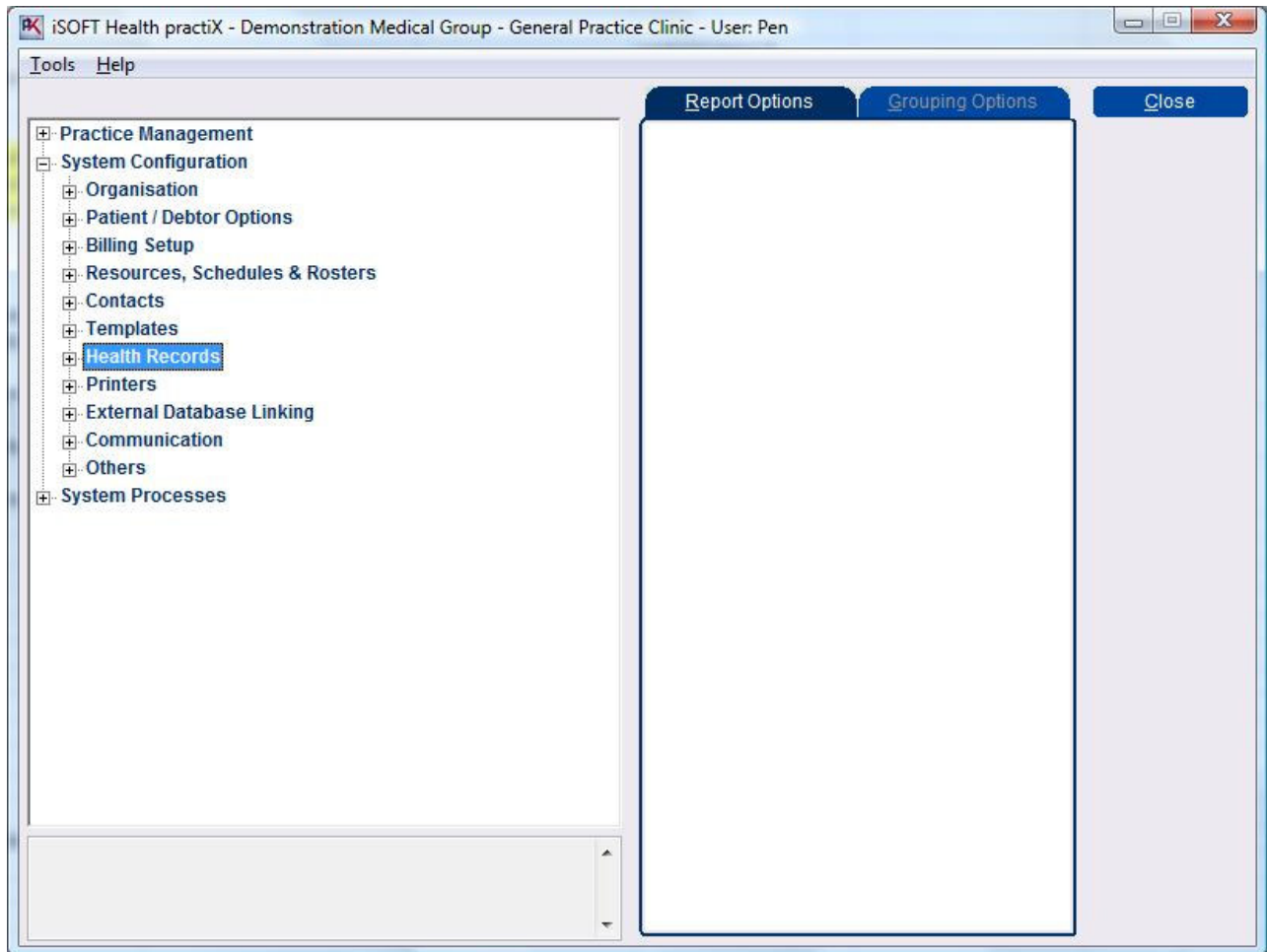
practiX CAT Notes - How to set up practiX Clinical Data Groups

- From the main menu click Administration



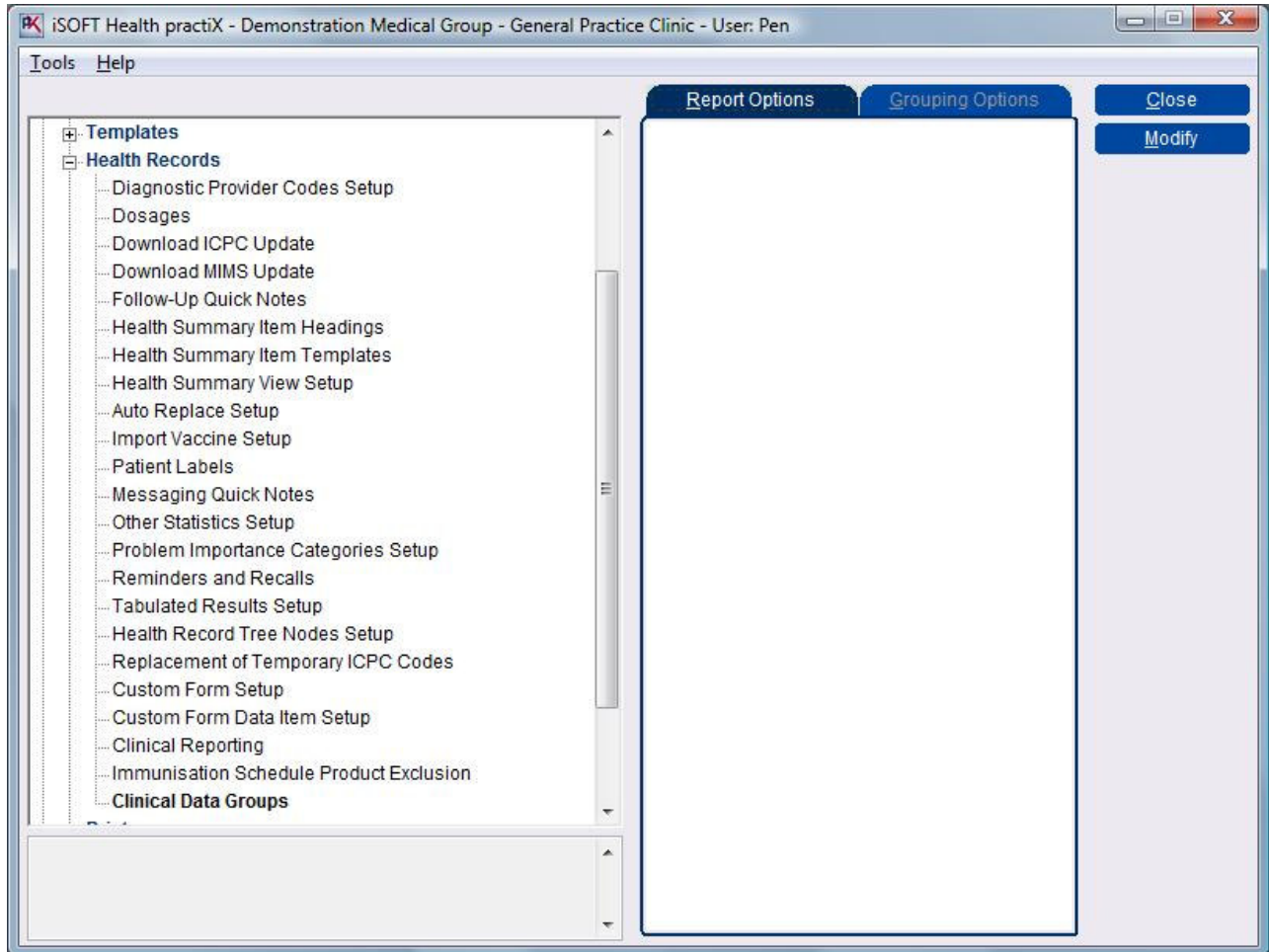
practiX main menu

- Open the System Configuration list
- Locate the Health Records item



practiX > Administration > System Configuration list

- Open the Health Records list
- Locate the Clinical Date Groups item
- Click on the Clinical Date Groups item
- Click the Modify button

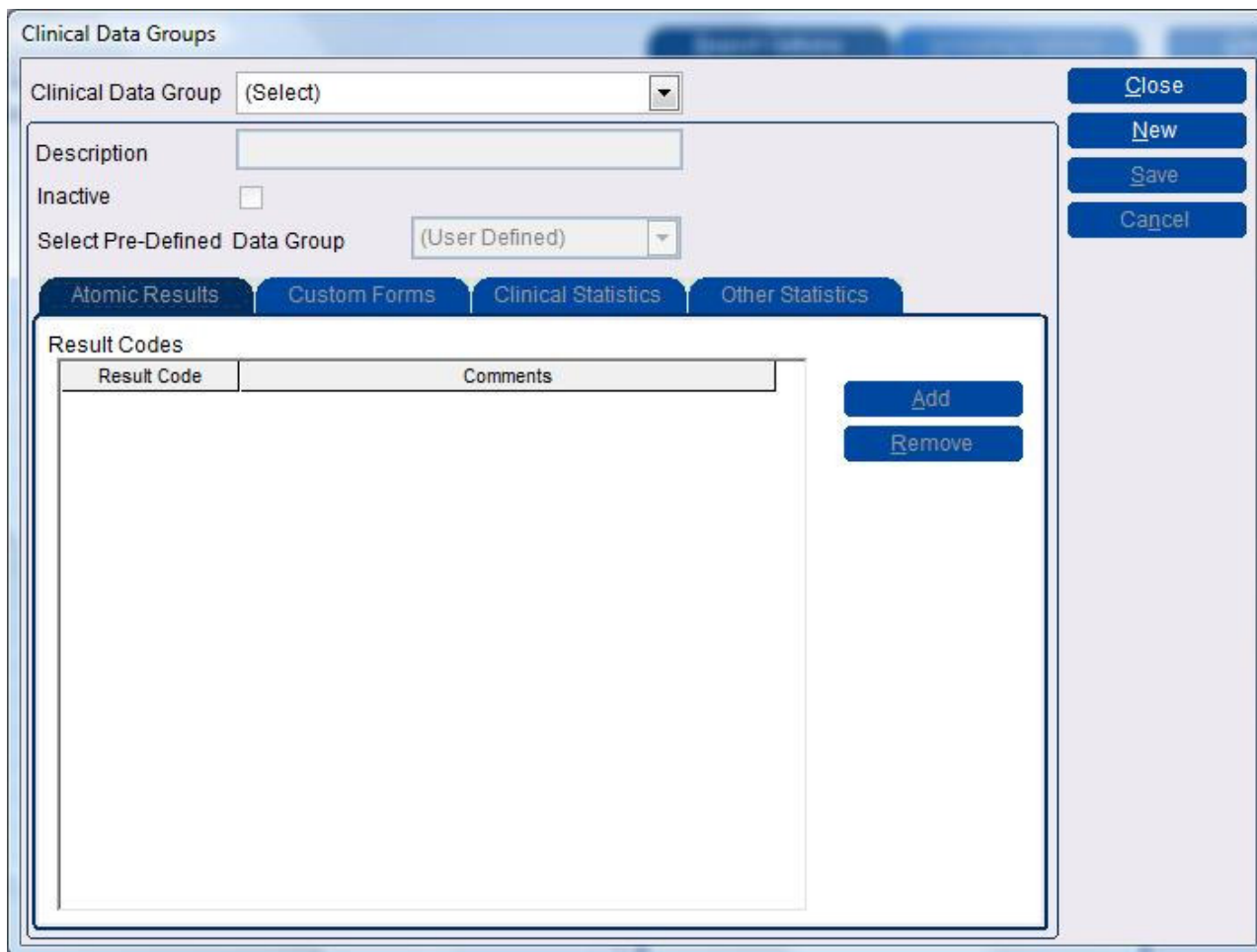


practiX > Administration > System Configuration > Health Records list

- The Clinical Data Groups (CDG) set up screen will open

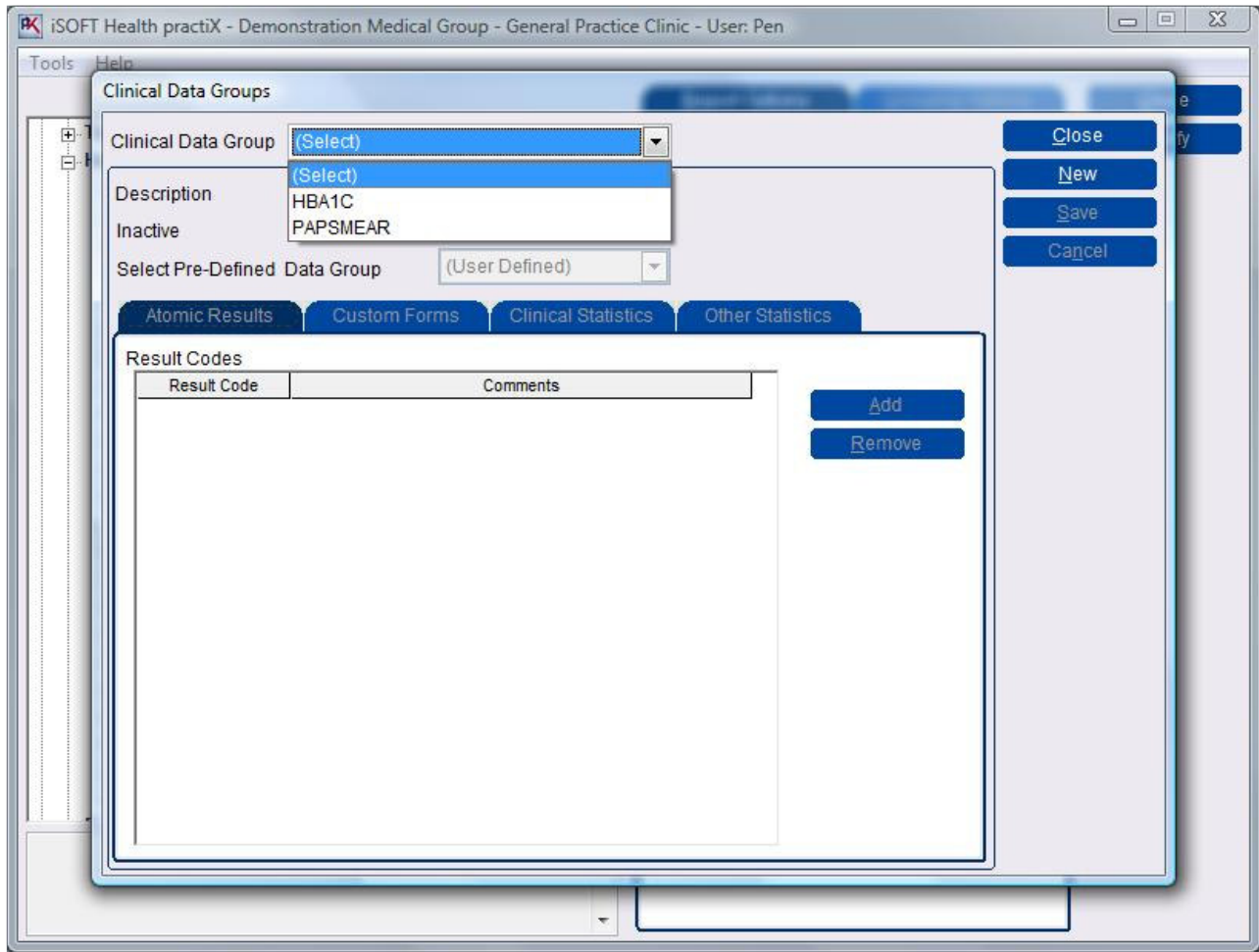
We will set up the HbA1c CDG as an example

- Click New
- The Description field will become editable
- Type HBA1C in the Description field
- Click Save
- The HBA1c group name will be saved in the Clinical Data Group drop down list



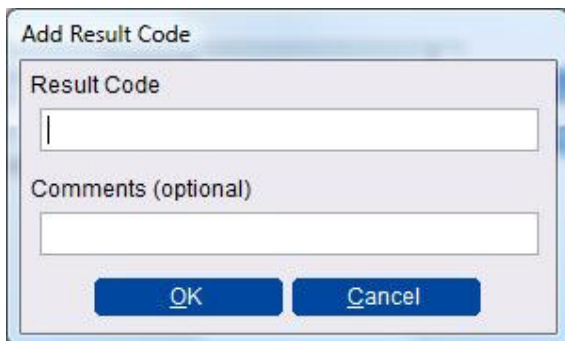
practiX Clinical Data Groups (CDG) set up screen

- Select HBA1c from the Clinical Data Group drop down list
- The Atomic Results tab becomes available for editing
- Click the Add button




practiX Clinical Data Groups (CDG) set up screen > CDG selection list

- Enter the result code 1785-6
- Enter a comment, for example, HBA1C Loinc
- Click OK



- Continue adding result codes for all the HbA1c pathology results that need to be picked up in this CDG (refer to the Clinical Audit Tool User Guide – practiX Data Mappings Appendix)
