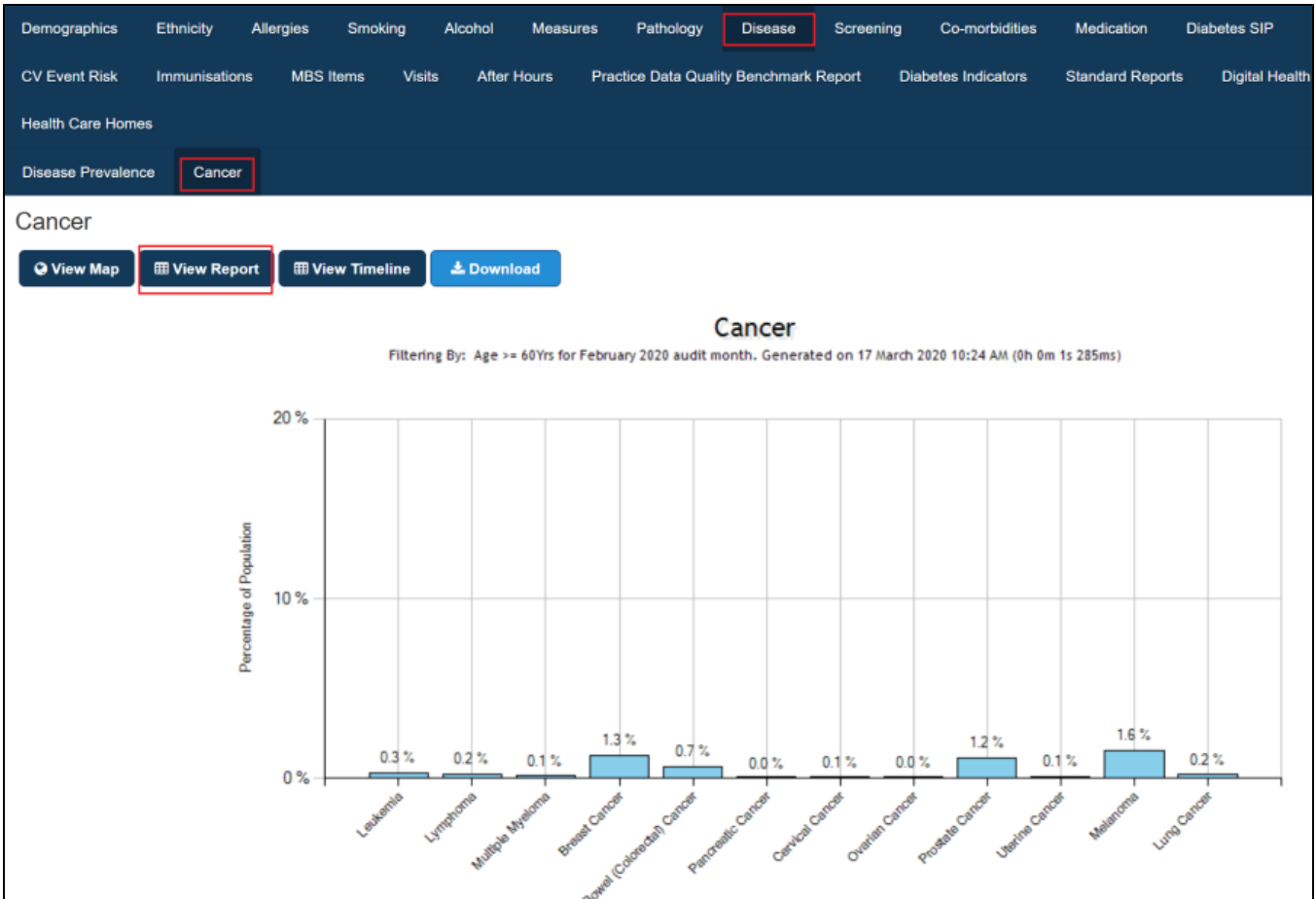
Recipe Name:	Patients with cancer

Target:	Patients with a cancer diagnosis
Recipe Limitations:	The cancer diagnosis needs to be coded in the patient record and 'active'
CAT Starting Point:	1. PAT CAT Open 2. Population Extract Loaded and Extract Pane "Hidden"
