Rationale:	Patients with chronic diseases are at high risk for Covid-19. This recipe will show you how to assess the numbers of these patients in your catchment
Target:	Patients with a current diagnosis of a chronic condition
Recipe Limitations:	Not all chronic conditions are reported in PAT CAT
CAT Starting Point:	1. PAT CAT Open 2. Population Extract Loaded and Extract Pane "Hidden"

Filter Steps:

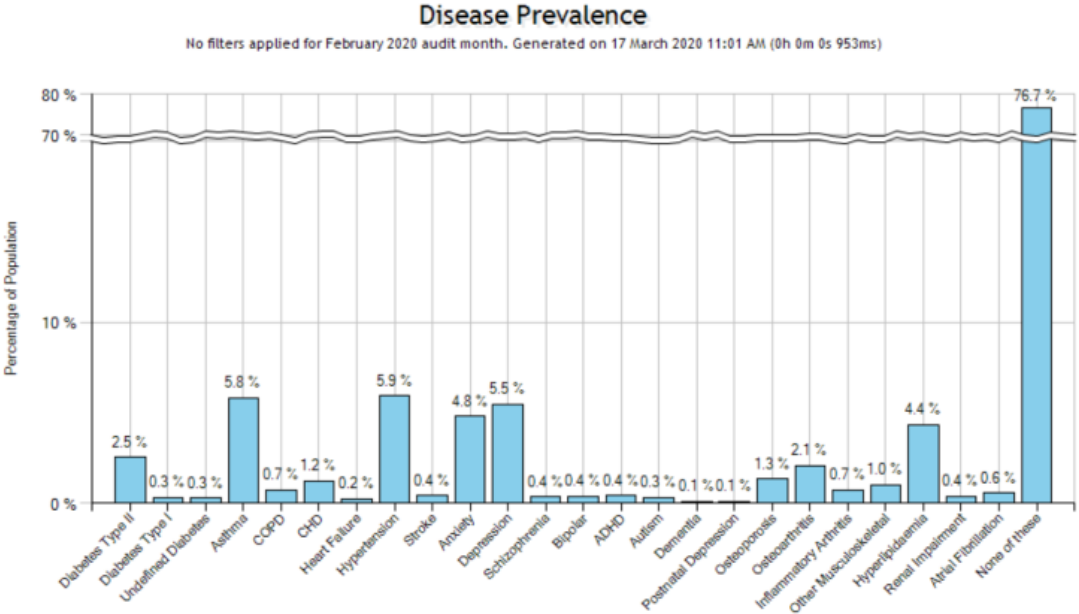
