## **Risk Factors Filtering**

The 'Risks Factors' Filter allows practices to filter for patients with risk factors: Smoking, Alcohol (Drinker and High Risk), Drug Abuse, Pregnancy, Obesity and transplant patient. In addition it allows filtering for patients with conditions that are associated with an increased risk of pneumococcal for immunisation purposes. The risk factors are defined as:

- Smoking daily or irregular smokers
- Alcohol drinker: drinks alcohol
- Alcohol drinker high risk: 2 or more drinks on a regular occasion or more than 4 drinks on any occasion
- Medication/Drug abuse coded diagnosis in patient record
- Pneumococcal has a condition that requires immunisation is up to date please refer to the page about adult immunisation for full details. This

- Pregnancy has active pregnancy in clinical record
- Obesity BMI of 30 or more
