
Find all patients currently residing in a RACF who are likely to benefit from a palliative care approach.




Recipe Name:	Find all patients currently residing in a RACF who are likely to benefit from a palliative care approach.
Rational e:	Patients living in RACFs are older, frail, have poor functional status, multiple comorbidities and compromised immune systems ¹ . This means that a palliative approach is often appropriate for most residents ² . Palliative care is recognised as core business for RACFs ³ .
	RACF residents receive less specialist palliative care support than those living at home and therefore are at greater risk of not having their palliative care needs identified and addressed ⁴ .
	This recipe assists practitioners, who are VMOs and care for patients residing in RACFs, to identify patients with potential palliative care needs.

Now all filter criteria have been set, please click on 'Recalculate' to apply the filter:























To see all patients with any RACF related MBS items, click on the 'View Population' icon:
