


Health Path Ways App

Unknown macro: 'export-link'

For organisations using HealthPathWays in their region the related Topbar app provides a simple one-click access to the HealthPathWays website. Topbar will show the app name (default is HealthPathWays) on top of your screen. In the screenshot below the PHN region name is displayed as well. This can be different for each PHN, but the icon will be the same for the app.

- 19 May – Alert: Ransomware cyber-attack affecting NHS in the UK**


