Recipe Name:	Identify female patients who are eligible for the Heart Health and have had a diagnosis of gestational diabetes.
Rationale:	Complications during pregnancy, such as gestational diabetes, can increase a women's risk of heart disease later in life¹. It is therefore important to conduct absolute CVD risk assessments (Heart Health Checks) in women who have had gestational diabetes. 1. Kramer CK, Campbell S, Retnakaran R. Target:	Female patients aged 30 and over with no diagnosis of CVD, no Heart Health Check or other health assessment item claimed in the past 12 months, and a diagnosis of gestational diabetes.
CAT Starting Point:	- CAT Open - CAT4 view (all reports) loaded - Population Extract Loaded and Extract Pane "Hidden" - Filter Pane open and under the 'General' tab 'Active Patients' (3x <2 years) selected (this step can be omitted if you want to search for all patients).

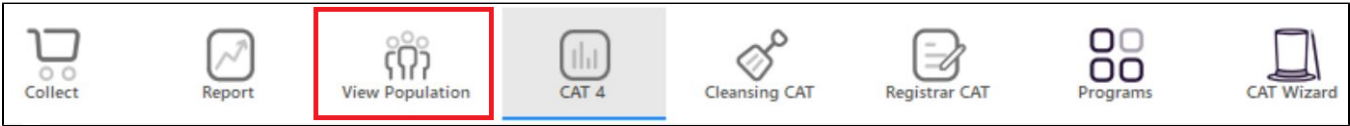

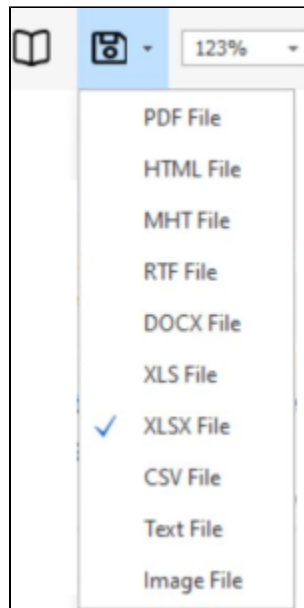
