

How to get started with CAT4 Recipes

CAT4 recipes provide many examples on how to use CAT4. While the recipes are designed for users of all experience levels, there are some things you need to know before you can follow the steps in the recipes. Full details can be found in the [online user guide](#) or the build in 'help' in CAT4.

First steps - log on to CAT4

You should have a username/password for our tools, if not, please contact your PHN or our support team.

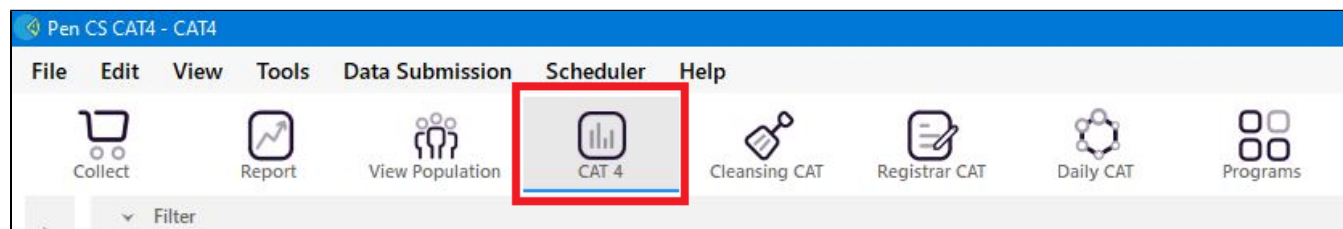
Double-click on the CAT4 icon on your desktop to start CAT4. If prompted to update, please do so!



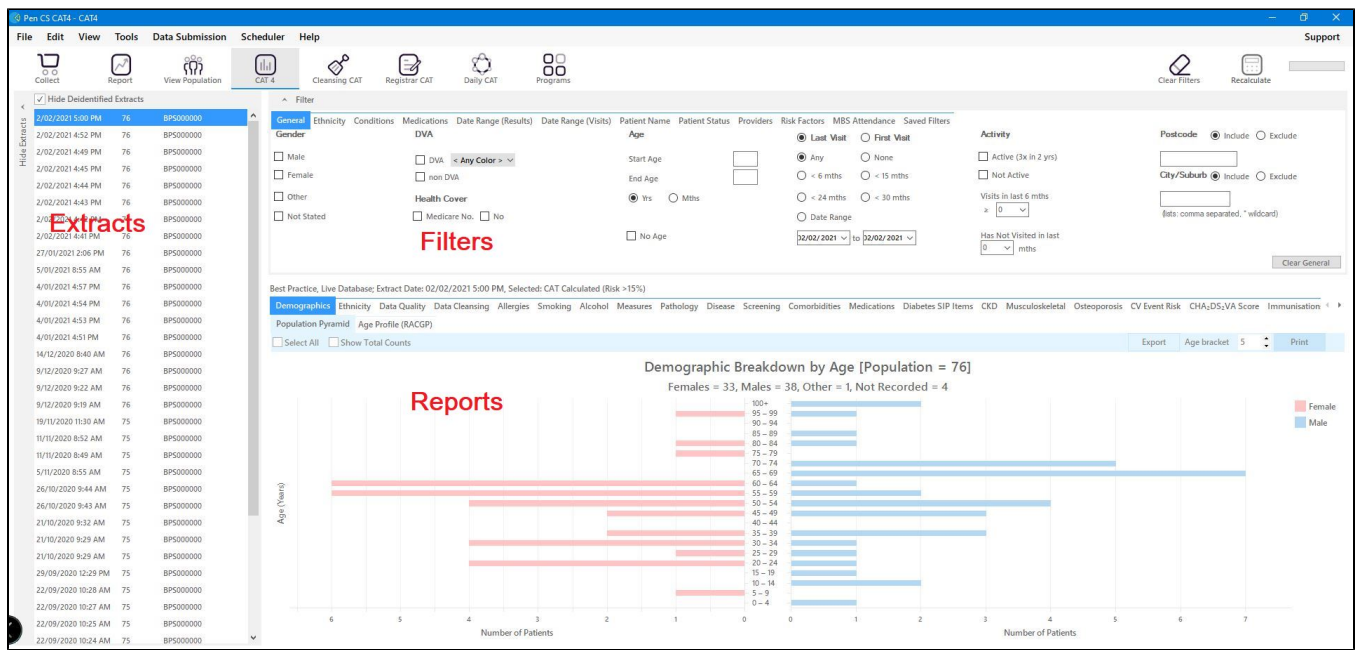
and then enter your user name and password to log on
